THE MAPUTO DECLARATION 2017

We, members attending the 1st German-African UNESCO Youth Climate Action Conference in Maputo,

Having understood the causes and effects of climate change and

Acknowledging the danger it poses to the whole world

Do hereby commit ourselves to achieve the following mitigation actions:

- 1. <u>Mobilize</u> communities and not limited to students only and bring them into awareness of the problem of climate change,
- 2. **Motivate** them into taking decisive action,
- 3. Initiate well planned projects to mitigate climate change effects,
- 4. <u>Undertake</u> to lobby school governance to put into consideration and plan for climate change activities within the school setting,

5.	<u>Establish</u> the necessary partnerships and networks to coordinate initiatives geared
	towards combating climate change issues,

- 6. <u>Integrate</u> environmental issues into our learning and school activities including but not limited to
 - a. subject content and
 - b. school clubs,
